

LONDON FIRE BRIGADE

Case File







The London Fire Brigade is run by the London Fire and Emergency Planning Authority and their organisation is part of a family of organisations under the 'umbrella' of the Greater London Authority.

The London Fire Brigade are the third largest fire fighting organisation in the world, protecting people and property from fire within the 1587 square kilometres of Greater London which has a resident population of 7 million, increased by another 500,000 during working hours.

The London Fire Brigade make London a safer city by minimising the risks and social and economic costs of fire and other hazards is their principal aim.

Richco was asked to tender on several stations on their appliance bay floors for The London Fire Brigade. Richco had to meet with many criteria set by The London Fire Brigade Authority as follows:

- To meet with their specified Slip Resistance Test (SRU Test).
- To give a ten-year warranty against failure of the products applied.
- To give a cleaning regime to ensure that the floor always met the required SRU test.

All completed works on the appliance bay floors for The London Fire Brigade were carried out on active stations and therefore the works was phased to ensure there was no downtime for the London Fire Brigade. The materials used were Richco Deck-a-Grip and E-Coat (500).

Richco continue to carry out works for the London Fire Brigade and all projects that have been completed by Richco are monitored on an annual basis.
